MINUTES OF THE GENERAL MEETING OF THE AAVSO HELD AT THE CONCORD ACADEMY, CONCORD, MASS. OCTOBER 18, 1975

The Saturday morning business session was called to order by President Scovil at 10:00 AM. Vote was taken accepting the Secretary's minutes of the May, 1975, General Meeting, as previously published in J.A.A.V.S.O., Vol. 4, No. 1. The President appointed tellers to collect and count ballots for the election of Council Members for the term 1975-77.

The Director presented her annual report for fiscal 1974-75, details of which appear elsewhere in this issue of the Journal. The report was loudly applauded. Members stood in respect while the names of members deceased during the year were read.

The Treasurer's Report for fiscal 1974-75 was summarized by Mr. Scovil, in the temporary absence of Treasurer R. Newton Mayall. A round of applause followed the report, in view of Mr. Mayall's successful achievement of balanced expenditures and receipts during a difficult financial year. The matching balance was \$70,678.

Mrs. Mattei presented a list of new membership applications approved by the Council at its meeting on October 17, 1975. Details of this list appear elsewhere in this issue of the The total number of 77 names on this list ranks as one of the largest on record for a single meeting of the Association.

The Director announced that the 1976 Spring Meeting of the AAVSO would be held at the McDonnell Planetarium in St. Louis, Missouri, on May 28-29, 1976. Dr. Whitney made some brief remarks about his new job as Editor of the Journal of the AAVSO before the Saturday morning meeting adjourned at 12 noon.

The Saturday afternoon session was called to order at 2:10 PM by Mr. Scovil, who turned over the chairmanship of the meeting to the newly-elected President George L. Fortier. Mr. Fortier called for and received a round of applause for the retiring President, Mr. Scovil.
