MINUTES OF THE GENERAL MEETINGS OF THE A.A.V.S.O. HELD AT THE HARVARD-SMITHSONIAN CENTER FOR ASTROPHYSICS, CAMBRIDGE, MA, 27 OCTOBER 1979

The annual report of the Treasurer for fiscal year 1978-79 was summarized by Emeritus Director Margaret W. Mayall. Copy of this report appears in JAAVSO for this meeting.

The President called for the annual report of the AAVSO Director, Mrs. Janet A. Mattei, for 1978-79, which also appears in JAAVSO.

The Director then announced that the 1980 Spring Meeting of the AAVSO would be held in Houston, Texas, on May 2-3, 1980. The

President announced that, at its meeting on October 26, 1979, the AAVSO Council voted to increase AAVSO annual dues as follows: Annual, \$10 to \$20; Junior, \$5 to \$10; Sustaining (minimum), \$20 to \$40. As an item of further business, Mr. Ernst Mayer described his correspondence with astronomers at the University of Chicago, observing at Mt. Lemmon Observatory, congratulating the AAVSO for furnishing charts and observations to help with their spectrographic observation.

The meeting was opened for papers at 11:50 AM. Papers numbered 1-3 on the attached list were presented before the Saturday morning session adjourned at 12:20 PM.

The Saturday afternoon session was called to order at 2:05 PM, with newly-elected President Carl A. Anderson in the chair. Following taking of a group photograph, the session re-convened for continuation of papers. Mr. Anderson asked that rising vote of appreciation be accorded to R. Newton Mayall for his service as Treasurer of the Association, in view of the succession of Theodore N. Wales to that office by Council vote at its Saturday noon meeting on October 27, 1979. Members rose and applauded Mr. Mayall not only for his recent work as Treasurer, but also for his faithful devotion to the AAVSO in many capacities over a period of more than 50 years since he became a member in the 1920's.

Papers numbered 4-15 on the attached list were then presented and discussed before a coffee break at about 4 PM. Papers numbered 16-21 were then presented without interruption before adjournment of the Saturday afternoon session at 5:40 PM.

A record number of well over 100 members and guests assembled at the Sheraton-Commander Hotel in Cambridge for the scheduled social hour and banquet. Following dinner, awards were presented to four discoverers of novae and supernovae - George Alcock for Nova Vulpeculae 1976 (NQ Vul), John Hosty for Nova Sagittae 1977 (HS Sge), AAVSOer Warren Morrison for Nova Cygni 1978 (V1668 Cyg), and AAVSOer Gus Johnson for an extragalactic supernova in NGC 4321 (M100) in 1979. The Banquet Speaker, Dr. L. Van Speybrook, from the Center For Astrophysics, brought us up to date on results from the "Einstein Observatory" x-ray satellite, with special attention to data which has been correlated with AAVSO visual data. The lecture led to an extensive question and answer session which finally adjourned about 10:45 PM.
